We will be using an online system called Sli.do to facilitate any questions in main plenaries and breakout sessions.

To ask a question, please go to www.slido.com [4] and type in event code **#NICEConf18**

On the top right-hand side, select the room that is hosting your session. The chair will confirm this at the beginning of the Q&A. You will then be able to type your question and submit it to be reviewed.

We will also have a roving microphone in each room if you would prefer to ask a question from the floor.

Please be aware that questions will be moderated before being submitted to each panel.
